

LTT report for AGM addendum

St Wilfrid's Church of England Primary Academy has achieved the Church School Distinctiveness award and is highly effective in building and maintaining links with the church and the wider community. Regular community afternoons are led by each year group across the school year and feedback is very positive. The school effectively teaches RE in accordance with Blackburn Diocese Syllabus, and is part of the pilot for the new syllabus. The daily act of Worship is of high quality and is in line with the ministry of the Church of England. Worship is based on the Christian Values of the school and the Christian calendar. Christian leadership is promoted in all aspects of the school and staff undertake a range of leadership and curriculum training delivered by the Diocese. Self evaluation of all aspects of the SIAMS framework is judged to be outstanding.

Canon Sharples CE Primary School and Nursery has achieved an overall outstanding judgement in its SIAMS inspection in November 2016. Leadership was judged to be Outstanding at all levels of the school. Christian character and the work the school does to meet the needs of all members of its community were highly praised and also judged to be outstanding. Worship was seen as a strength of the school as the school has developed an excellent pattern of worship and worship cycle that the children and whole school community respond well to. The school is currently working with the Diocese of Liverpool and the local church communities to achieve the Church Distinctiveness award.
