Wednesday 10th May 2017	Mathematics Paper 1: Arithmetic Mathematics Paper 2: Reasoning
Thursday 11th May 2017	Mathematics Paper 3: Reasoning

It is essential that your child is present and punctual throughout SATs week. During this week, it is beneficial for your child to have a good night's sleep and a substantial breakfast.

We will be having a Mock SATs week during the week commencing Monday 24th April. This will provide the children with an experience similar to SATs week, enabling them to feel more familiar and comfortable with the process.

In order for children to fulfil their potential in these tests, it is advisable that learning continues during the Easter Break, through a programme of revision. We will provide the children with some practice SATs papers and suggest that they continue to work through the SATs Buster Books which many parents purchased earlier this year
