We launched our 'Agents of Jesus' calendar at the beginning of January 2024, and children and staff have been 'Agents of Kindness' and 'Agents of Love' during the months of January and February.

During Spring Term 1, children have engaged in our Literacy-Rich Curriculum, working hard, deepening their knowledge and vocabulary, developing skills and making great progress in their learning.

Our Literacy-Rich Curriculum is enhanced by Extra-Curricular clubs, Enrichment opportunities and Trust Experiences. Children have enjoyed a wide range of Extra-Curricular clubs during Spring Term 1, including Messy Play, Craft, Choir, Multi-Sports, Drama & Games, Lego Robotics, Botley Robotics, Design Technology, Recorders and Ukulele.

Enrichment has included inspirational visitors and exciting educational visits across school. Visitors have included a Spaceman in Year 2 to launch their new focus theme 'All Aboard!', a Firefighter to Year 1 as part of their focus theme 'London's Burning', Dr. Sheila to Year 4 as part of their RE unit 'What is Prayer?' and a Generator Technician to Year 4 as part of their Science topic 'Electricity'. All children from Reception to Year 6 have engaged in online safety workshops delivered by One Day Creative. Educational visits have included Turton Tower for Year 3 as part of their focus theme 'Off with Her Head!' and the Imperial War Museum for Year 6 as part of their focus theme 'Wigan at War'. We also enjoyed a KS2 Ash Wednesday Service at Church led by Year 6 to mark the season of Lent.

Learning Together Trust Experiences have included a career and aspirations day for Year 6 children at Edge Hill University. Year 3 children can look forward to their Trust Experience to Liverpool after half term, where they will visit Tate Gallery and Maritime Museum, and enjoy a 'Ferry across the Mersey'.
