Re: Parent Survey 2018

Dear Parents/Carers,

During the Summer Term a Parent Survey was distributed to all parents and carers. 169 surveys were returned to school and I would like to thank you for taking the time to complete this survey. I would like to share with you the outcome.

- 98.8% agreed that 'My child is happy at this school' (78.1% strongly agree and 35.2% agree)
- 100% agreed that 'My child feels safe at this school' (85.2% strongly agree and 14.8% agree)
- 99.4% agreed that 'My child makes good progress at this school' (81.7% strongly agree and 17.8% agree)
- 98.8% agreed that 'My child is well looked after at this school' (80.5% strongly agree and 18.3% agree)
- 100% agreed that 'My child is taught well at this school' (85.2% strongly agree and 14.8% agree)
- 90.5% agreed that 'My child receives appropriate homework for their age' (58% strongly agree and 32.5% agree, with 5.3% didn't know)
- 92.9% agreed that 'The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved' (60.9% strongly agree and 32% agree, with 4.1% didn't know)
- 95.9% agreed or stated they didn't know as they hadn't experienced it that 'The school deals effectively with bullying' (36.1% strongly agree, 18.3% agree and 41.4% don't know)
- 96.4% agreed that 'The school is well led and managed' (72.2% strongly agree and 24.3% agree)
- 97% agreed or stated they didn't know as they hadn't experienced it that 'The school responds well to any concerns I raise' (63.3% strongly agree, 27.8% agree and 5.9% don't know)
- 98.8% agreed that 'I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress' (71% strongly agree and 27.8% agree)
- 98.8% stated that they would recommend the school to another parent.

Thank you also for the written feedback, which was overwhelmingly positive, with some constructive feedback, which have taken into consideration in our development planning for this academic year.

We look forward to another exciting year ahead and would like to thank you for your continued support.
