Please note, Reception Year 1 and Year 2 Christmas Assemblies will be **ticket only**. These will be provided later this week.

On **Monday 17th December** children in **Reception, Year 1 and 2** will be having a Christmas party. Children may come into school in their party clothes. Children will still be going outside for playtime and lunchtime, so please ensure that they wear suitable clothing and shoes. The children will be having their lunch as normal, but will need to bring an additional 'party plate' of food to eat in the afternoon. This might consist of sandwiches, sausage rolls, crisps, biscuits or cakes etc. This should be on a disposable plate, covered with cling film or foil and labelled with your child's name and class.

Children in Key Stage 2 will be having their Christmas party on the following dates:

Children in KS2 are expected to wear their school uniform during the morning of their party and they will change into their party clothes after lunch. KS2 children will also need to bring a 'party plate' of food for the afternoon.

Finally, as we have children in school with nut allergies, please do not bring nuts or any food containing nuts.
