Dear Parents/Carers,

On **Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November** we will be holding our **Christmas Fair at 3.30 pm** in the Key Stage 2 hall. There will be a variety of Festive stalls, events, Santa's Grotto, refreshments and games for all the family to enjoy. As in the past we would be grateful if you could send some items in for our stalls e.g. *bottles, toiletries, filled gift bags, cakes, Christmas themed items (for the tombola), prizes (for the raffle) and/or toys (for the toy stall).*

We shall be having a Christmas gift bag stall again. If you could please fill a Christmas gift bag (any size) with something, examples being Christmas gifts, sweets, chocolates, soft toys, colouring pencils or books and send it in.

The biscuit decorating stall will have a festive theme and was very popular in previous years. We would appreciate any donations of gingerbread biscuits, icing tubes, mini marshmallows or small sweets such as mini smarties. We will also have 'snowman kebab' making for which we need standard size white marshmallows and black icing tubes.

The Christmas tombola was also very popular last year, so please can you send your child in with anything festive themed for example; selection boxes, mince pies, Christmas crackers, Christmas craft etc. This year we are asking that tombola prizes are **wrapped** in Christmas gift paper so that they are a surprise for the winner.

We will be having a cake stall which we would like your support with, so if you are able, could you please send cakes in **on the day**. Items for the other stalls can be sent into school now and will be greatly received.

**Friday 29<sup>th</sup> November will also be Christmas themed non-uniform day for which the children will pay £1 for the privilege. We look forward to seeing Christmas jumpers and Christmas head wear e.g. head bands, clip ins.**

Please could you also support the raffle. **Two strips** of raffle tickets are attached to this letter, and the tickets cost £1.00 per strip. Please could you **write your child's name and class on each full strip**, keep one strip for yourself and then return one strip to school with the money. This may be given to your child's class teacher or at the office.

Your support is, as ever, greatly appreciated as the money raised does give the children many extras that the school budget cannot provide. To reduce queues, there will be no entrance fee, and access for the fair will be through the main entrance to the Cedar Building (KS2 Building). We are in need of people to help on the day, both for setting up and running the stalls. If you can help please return the slip below, without your support we will be unable to run this event.
