

leaf	one of the usually flat green parts that grow from a plant stem and that functions mainly in making food		<input type="checkbox"/> 85% of plant life is found in the ocean.	
root	A root is a part of a plant that is usually hidden underground. ... They hold the plant in the ground and keep it upright. They take water and food from the soil. They also store food for the plant.		<input type="checkbox"/> Plants produce the oxygen that is in the air we breath.	
bulb	Bulbs are underground masses of food storage from which plants grow.	 	<input type="checkbox"/> Plants come in all colours, shapes and sizes.	
seed	Seeds are the small parts produced by plants from which new plants grow. In a flowering plant, three parts work together to help a seed develop and grow into a new plant.		<input type="checkbox"/> Plants create food for animals to eat.	
stem	The stem is the main part of the plant. It supports the weight of the leaves, as well as the flowers or fruit.			
habitat	The place where a plant or animal (mostly) lives. There are different kinds of habitats, such as grassland, forest, river, sea and desert.			
oxygen	Oxygen is used by animals and plants in the respiration (breathing) process.
