Begin to recognise that words start with the same sound.

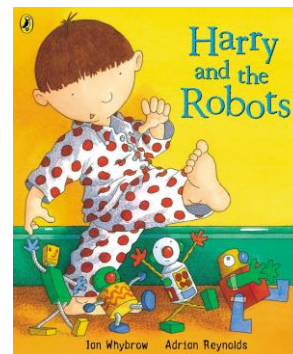
Begin to write letters to represent my name.

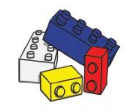
