MUSIC TUITION REQUEST

Dear Parents and Carers.

We are now taking requests for new music instrumental lessons, to start in September 2024.

We are pleased to be able to offer the following tuition:

violin / viola*

cello

brass*

piano

guitar (acoustic)

flute / clarinet / bassoon / saxophone / oboe*

singing

*the final choice of instrument is between the pupil and teacher

Lessons are taken weekly, on the same day and generally at the same time and will be either during the school day, or after school. This will depend on the instrumental teacher's timetable.

Beginner pupils often choose to have a small group lesson, which costs £4.99 a week, however there is the opportunity to have an individual 20 minute lesson for £11.49, or an individual 30 minute lesson for £17.99. The amount payable will be calculated for each ½ term (based on the number of weeks applicable) and must be paid for in advance. Fees are not refundable if your child does not attend a lesson, however refunds will be given if the music teacher is absent for whatever reason.

Pianos are available for use in school; however instruments are required for all other lessons. If you need to hire an instrument, please contact Wigan Music Service on 01942 776169 for further information. Your child's instrumental teacher will also be able to advise. There is an Assisted Tuition Scheme which parents can apply for, to help with the cost of learning a musical instrument, please contact Wigan Music Service for more information.

If your child would like to start to learn to play a musical instrument, please email kflynn@saintwilfrids.wigan.sch.uk and state your child's name, current class, instrument and length of lesson (small group, 20 mins, 30 mins). This information must be emailed by Monday 10th June. Once this information is received then you will receive a payment letter, all payments should be made on ParentPay, with a strict deadline date.

If your child already has instrumental lessons through school, then you do not need to reply to this letter, unless you would like their lesson time increased. You will receive your payment letter soon, as usual.
