"It has been very fun and I have felt really welcomed and supported and made lots of good friends."



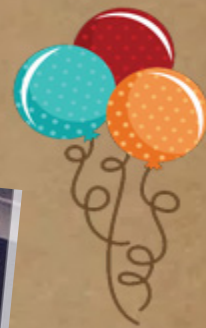
"Wet green paper towels. I always wanted a plaster or an ice pack, but all I ever got was a wet green paper towel."







Thank you St Wilfrid's, thank you all the teachers - I had a great time and made great friend's and memories. Will miss everyone 😞





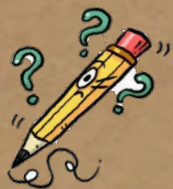
"From Reception right through to 6D

Cos come September, Standish High ???"



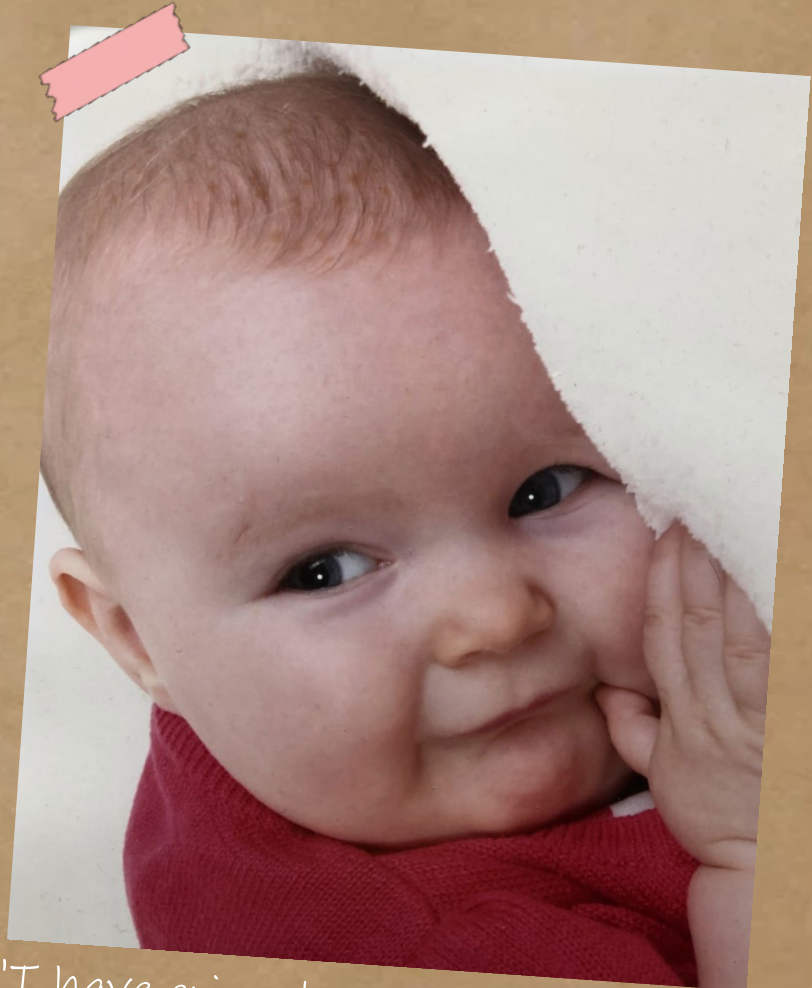

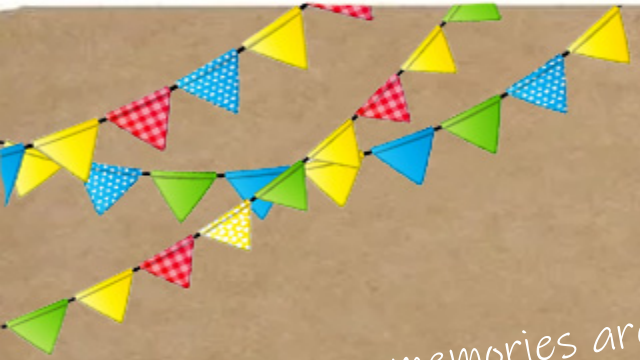


"I have enjoyed my time at St Wilfrids. I have made some amazing friends and even though it has been cut short I am looking forward to our next journey at high school together. See you all soon."

"My favourite memories are getting silver medals at cross country and sports hall athletics."



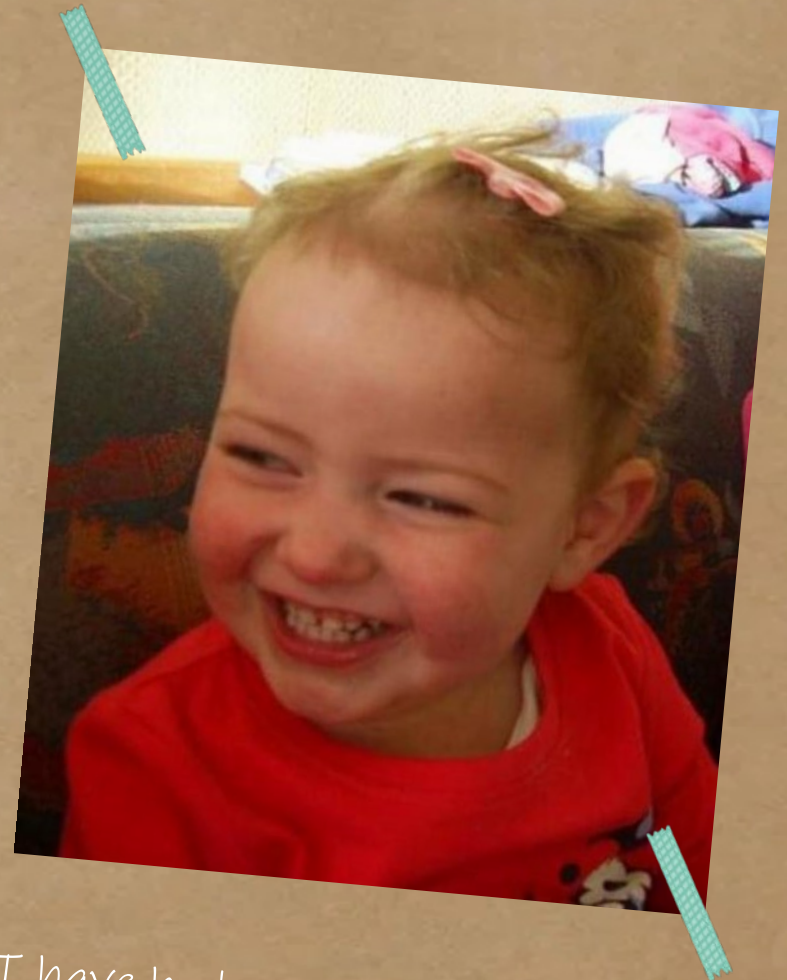

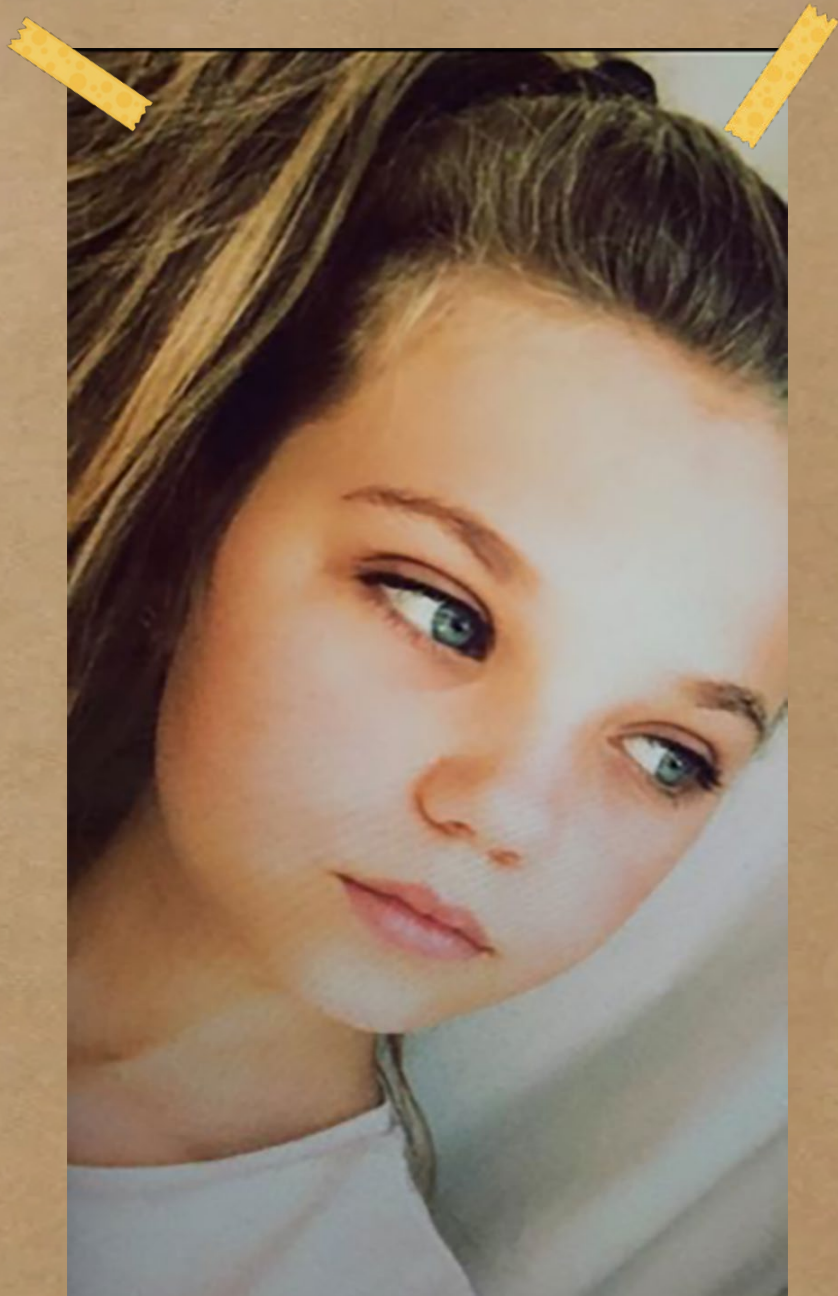

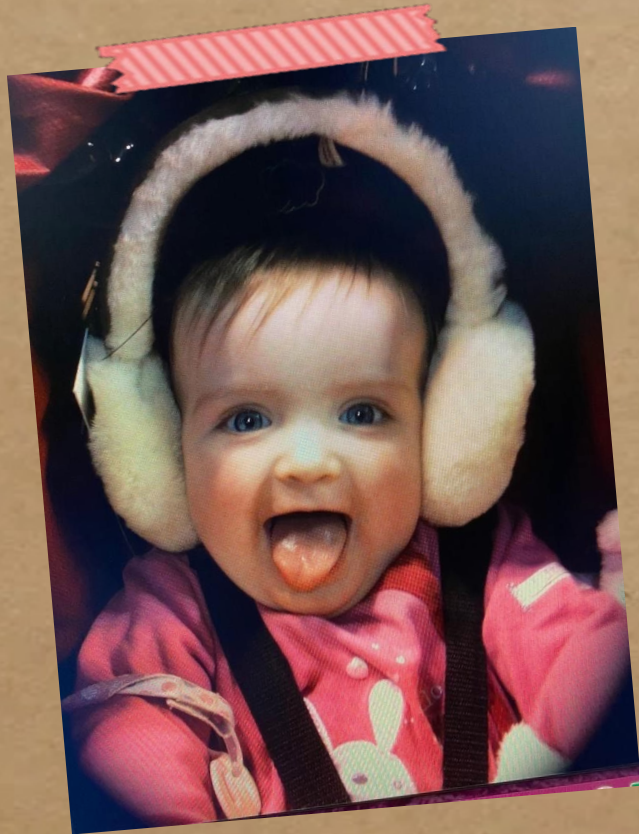




"The best part about my time at St Wilfs is that I have met mates that are like brothers to me, we built a grassroots football team in year 1 and are still together now!"

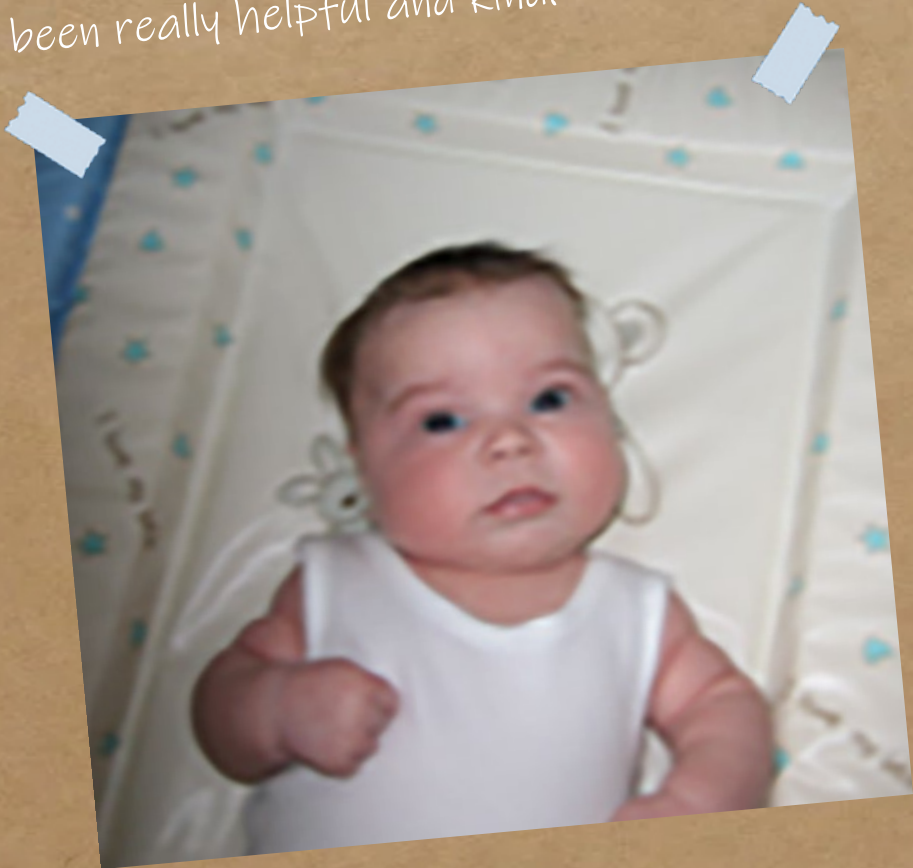

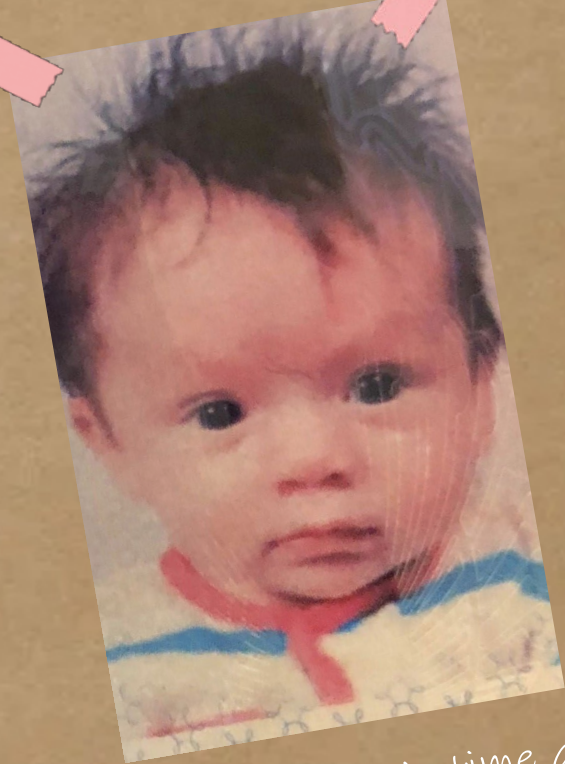

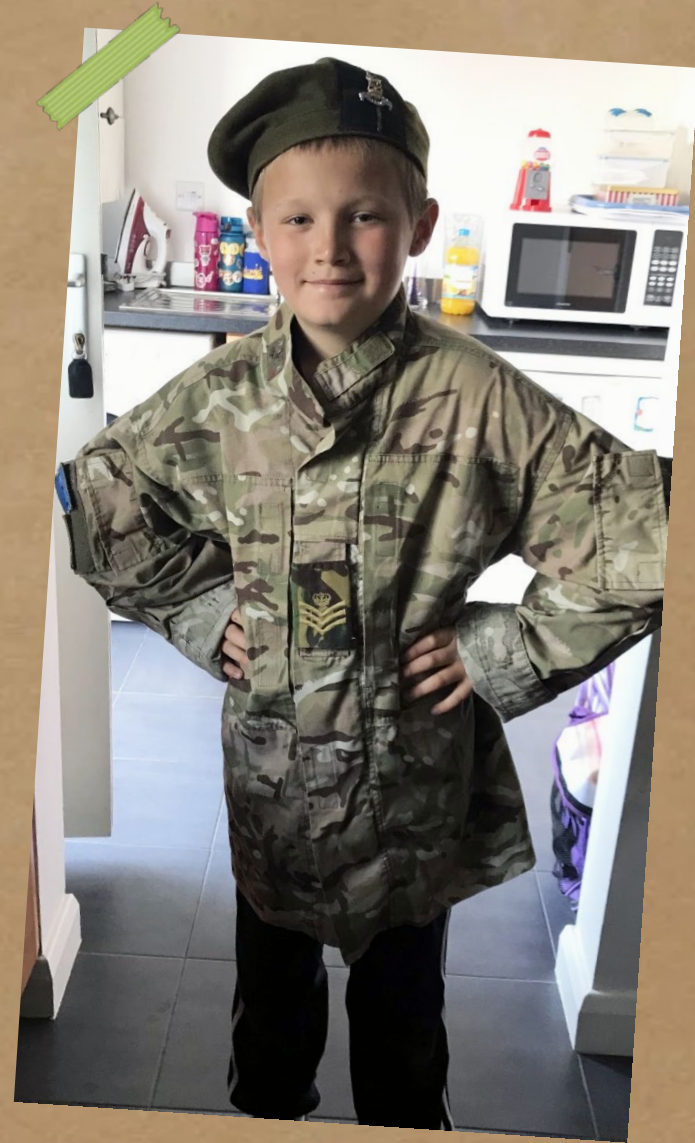
